Elementary/Middle School Group

February Schedule:

Sundays and Wednesdays 6:30-8:00

Starting March 1:

Sundays 3:15-4:45 and Wednesdays 6:30-8:00

Price:

High School Group (grades 8-12)

The Spring and Summer session runs from **March through July**. There are two high school groups:

- \Rightarrow **Orange:** 145 lbs and up
- ⇒ **Red**: Under 145 lbs

Practice Schedule (starting March 1):

- \Rightarrow **Orange:** Sundays and Mondays 5-6:30
- \Rightarrow **Red**: Sundays and Mondays 6:45-8:15

Workouts continue in August-October as well.
